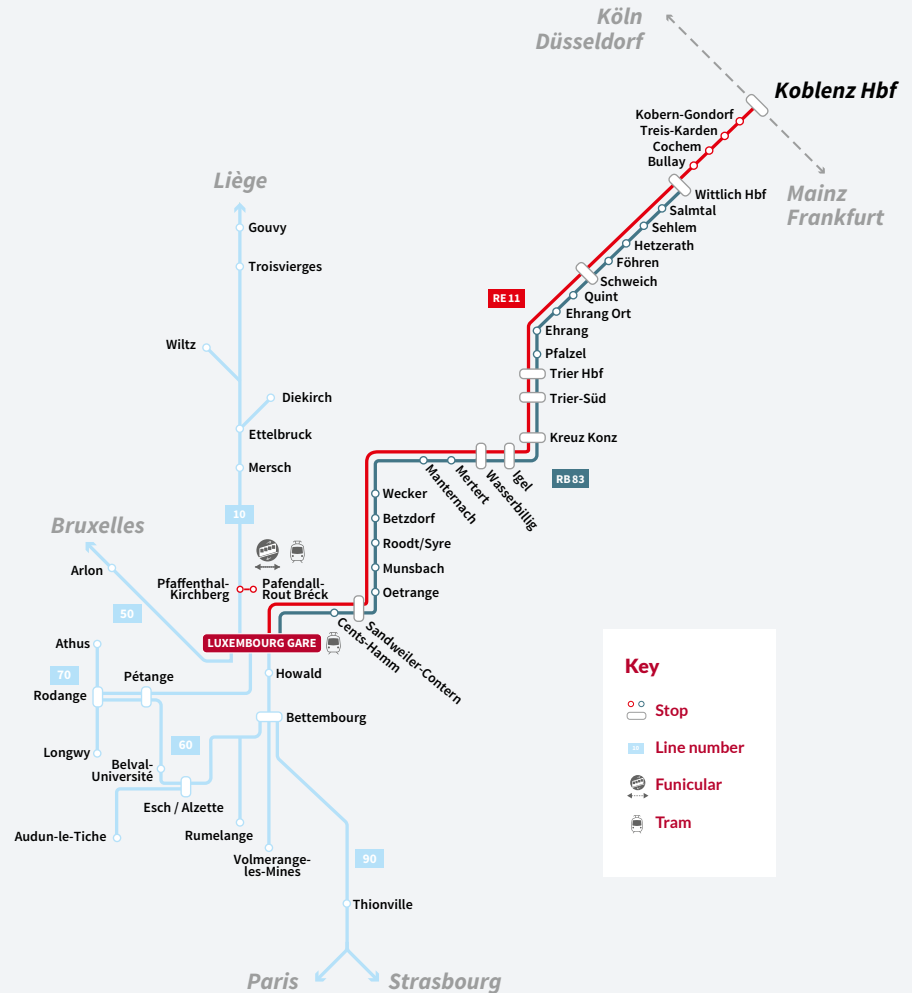

Relaxed commuting

Do you want a stress-free, comfortable and affordable journey to work? No traffic jams, no need to search for a parking space or battle with the elements? And you want mobility that's environmentally friendly and sustainable? Then get on board our public transport services!

Attractive mobility services between Germany and Luxembourg

The cross-border rail passenger service will bring you safely to your place of work in modern, comfortable trains running on regional rail route RB 83 and regional express route RE 11. Cross-border RGTR bus services between Germany and Luxembourg expand your mobility options. If you also take advantage of the affordable tickets and tariffs, nothing will stand in the way of your commute by public transport. Ticket prices for trains and buses are calculated to the Luxembourg border because use of public transport and local 2nd class trains is free in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.



By train: Lines RB 83 and RE 11

The following lines offer cross-border mobility with frequent services from early until late:

RB 83: Wittlich – Luxembourg

RB 83 starts in Wittlich and stops at all railway stations on the German* and Luxembourg** side, including Schweich, Trier Hbf and Igel.

Hourly direct connection from Wittlich to Luxembourg:

Monday to Saturday, between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m.

From Luxembourg to Wittlich:

Monday to Saturday, between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.

RE 11: Koblenz – Trier – Luxembourg

Regional express route RE 11 runs hourly between Koblenz, Trier and Luxembourg**.

From Koblenz to Trier and Luxembourg:

Daily, between 6 a.m. and 11 p.m.

From Luxembourg to Trier and Koblenz:

Daily, between 5 a.m. and 11 p.m.

* except Karthaus

** A rail replacement service is in operation. The following stops are omitted:
Line RB 83: Cents-Hamm and Sandweiler-Contern
Line RE 11: Luxembourg Hbf (main station)

By bus: RGTR buses

You can also travel conveniently from Germany to Luxembourg using the cross-border RGTR buses. Take advantage of the preferential rate for RegioZone tickets. On cross-border RGTR buses, free travel applies within Luxembourg to the last stop before the border or to the border, if there is a bus stop there.



Restricted rail service between Luxembourg and Wasserbillig until December 12th

The line between Luxembourg and Sandweiler-Contern is closed for engineering works. RE 11 trains are not calling at stations between Luxembourg Hbf (main station) and Sandweiler-Contern. RB 83 trains are running via an alternative route to Luxembourg Hbf (main station), which skips the stops Cents-Hamm and Sandweiler-Contern. A rail replacement service is in operation. Limited bike transport options between Luxembourg and Oetrange

A small number of bicycles are permitted on rail replacement services, assuming that a free space is available and the driver gives permission to board. Please note that wheelchair users and pushchairs always take priority. All restrictions will be lifted from 12 December.



OekoCard – the first choice for commuters

For the Wittlich – Trier – Luxembourg route

The OekoCard is valid on trains on the cross-border route Wittlich – Trier – Luxembourg and on all public transport buses and trains in Luxembourg. To obtain the personal season ticket, customers residing in Germany require certification from their employer in Luxembourg*.

The OekoCard customer card, which is valid for one year and is to be shown at ticket control, can be obtained in DB Travel Centres or from CFL in Luxembourg Station. To obtain the OekoCard, customers residing in Luxembourg must simply show an official Luxembourg identification document.

Luxembourg Special Day Return Ticket

Are you based in Trier but have occasional appointments in Luxembourg? Then the Luxembourg Special is the ticket for you: It is valid for inbound and outbound travel on local trains (RE, RB) from Trier Hbf (main station) to Luxembourg via the border crossing at Igel.

Rhineland-Palatinate Ticket + Lux

Are you travelling with your team? The Rhineland-Palatinate Ticket + Lux is valid for one day for up to five people travelling together in Rhineland-Palatinate (Rheinland-Pfalz) and Saarland on cross-border rail passenger services and on transport association public transport in Rhineland-Palatinate (bus, tram) and Luxembourg.

Cross-border bus tickets

RegioZone tickets are available as daily tickets and season tickets at two fare levels: RegioZone 1 for all cross-border RGTR buses (except Line 156 and the Saarbrücken Express) and RegioZone 2 for Line 156 and the Saarbrücken Express.
